Our Service Area encompasses Alcona, Alpena, Cheboygan, Chippewa, Emmet, Iosco, Otsego, Oscoda, Mackinac, Montmorency, Presque Isle, and Luce Counties.

Challenges of our Service Area Population

The population of patients in our Service Area face serious challenges for healthcare access due to widespread economic and social deprivation, joblessness, underemployment, geographic isolation, harsh climate, and lack of transportation and other resources.

Further, patients in our Service Area statistically exceed the State of Michigan for adult obesity, proportion of adults reporting diagnosis of high blood pressure, and age adjusted deaths from diseases of the heart and diabetes.

97,309 people or roughly 39% of residents in our Service Area are individuals who are under 200% of Federal Poverty Level guidelines, underinsured or uninsured, or receiving Medicare or Medicaid benefits.

Due to this, Alcona Health Center recognizes the importance of offering a full array of services including health education, eligibility screenings, care management, care coordination, and community resource referrals.
