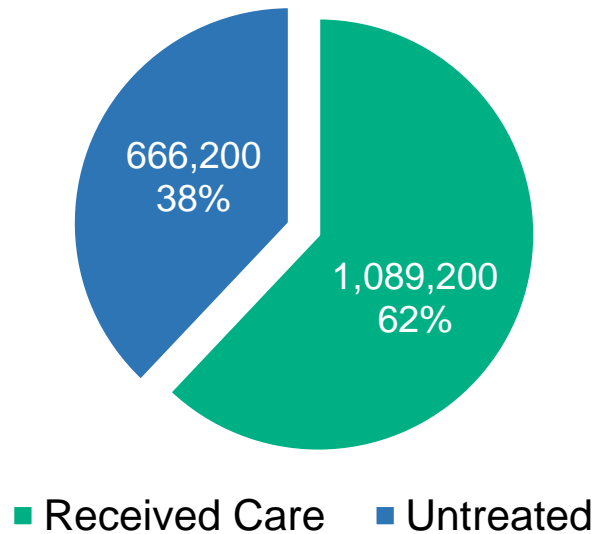

ALL INSURANCE TYPES – ANY MENTAL ILLNESS

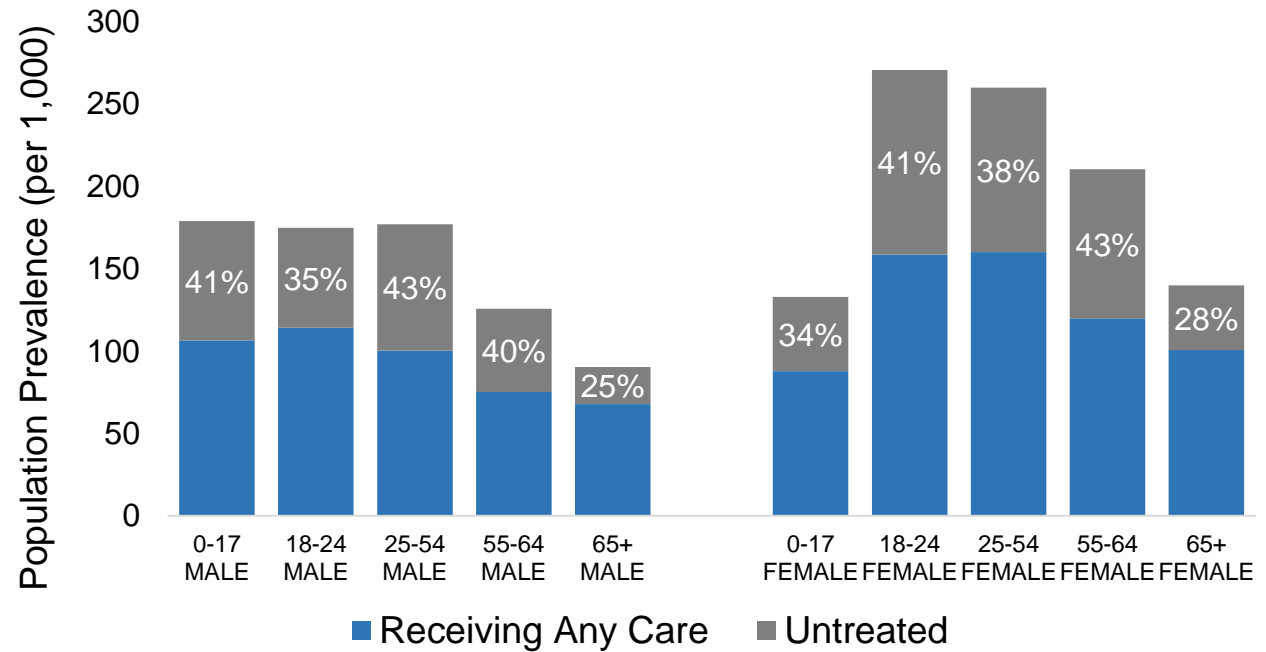
2016 Michigan population estimate: **9,928,300**

Any Mental Illness Unmet Need in Michigan, by Age & Sex

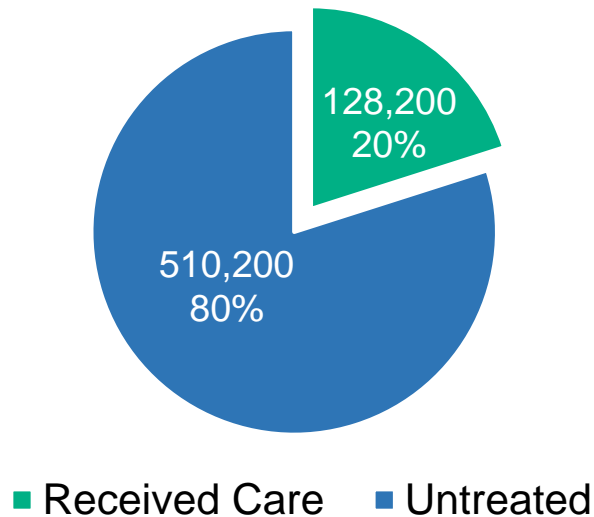


ALL INSURANCE TYPES – SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER
