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Defining Health

- ▣ Medical Model of Care:
 - Health is an absence of any signs or symptoms of disease.
- ▣ W.H.O.
 - “Health is a state of complete physical, mental, and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity.”

How we define health will change how health can and should be evaluated

Healthy Michigan Plan Outcomes

- ▣ 638,845 beneficiaries receiving coverage
- ▣ Higher rates of diagnosis for chronic conditions
- ▣ Greater access to primary care
- ▣ Encouragement of healthy behaviors
- ▣ Reduced stress and improved financial stability

Comparing Expansion States to Non-Expansion States

- ▣ Closing the coverage gap
- ▣ Better margins and stability for rural care centers and safety-net institutions
- ▣ Decreased uncompensated care
- ▣ Health sector job growth
- ▣ Stronger health systems for all patients
