FEATURED SPEAKER:

The **Michigan Political Leadership Program** at Michigan State University is a bipartisan fellowship program designed for those seeking greater involvement in the public policy process, through elective office or through citizen activism. MPLP is distinguished as one of only a handful of programs of its kind in the nation. Housed in the College of Social Science, MPLP is administered by the Institute for Public Policy and Social Research, directed by Dr. Matt Grossmann.

Since its 1992 inception, over 700 MPLP fellows have participated in our 10-weekend curriculum which focuses on practical politics, public policy analysis and process, personal leadership development, and effective governance. More than half of MPLP's graduates have served in elected office and/or appointed leadership positions. Each year, our fundraising event takes place to raise the necessary funding to support the 24 fellowships that are awarded to aspiring policy leaders. Each fellowship is valued at approximately \$12,000.
